What You Need

- An Internet-connected computer. (eBooks are compatible with Windows and Mac computers.)
- A valid Orland Park Public Library card.

Free software available via www.mediaondemand.org.

How to Use Media on Demand

Downloading eBooks and other media from your library is easy! It's like online shopping. Just follow these easy steps:

➡ Step 1: Browse

Browse the digital catalog at www.mediaondemand.org

You may also search by title, subject, author, format and other criteria. Convenient categories are accessible from each page. Title pages also include icons signifying device or computer compatibility.

➡ Step 2: Check Out

Add selections to your 'Cart'. *Note: If a title is not available, you may place a hold. You will receive an email when the title is available for checkout.*

Kindle users – please be sure to select the "Kindle Book" format when you are choosing a title to check out.

Click on the 'Proceed to Checkout' link and enter your library card number and password (the default password is your last name).

➡ Step 3: Download... Enjoy!

Click on the 'Download' button under each title to launch Adobe Digital Editions.

Kindle users – instead of a Download button, you will see a button that says "Get for Kindle." Click on it to go to Amazon's website and complete the transfer of your book to your Kindle device.

Once downloaded, eBook titles can be enjoyed on your computer and can be transferred to a supported portable eReader! *See the "How to Transfer eBooks" section for details.*

Kindle eReaders

Amazon is now offering access to Media on Demand eBooks through Kindle devices and apps. Please be sure to select Kindle format eBooks when choosing the book you will be checking out. After completing the check-out procedure, Media on Demand will provide you with a button that links you into Amazon.com. Sign in to Amazon with your Kindle account, and follow the on-screen instructions to select your Kindle device and transfer the title via their Whispersync network. Media on Demand titles can be transferred to both Kindle eReaders and Kindle apps.

Nook, Sony, Kobo and Other eReaders

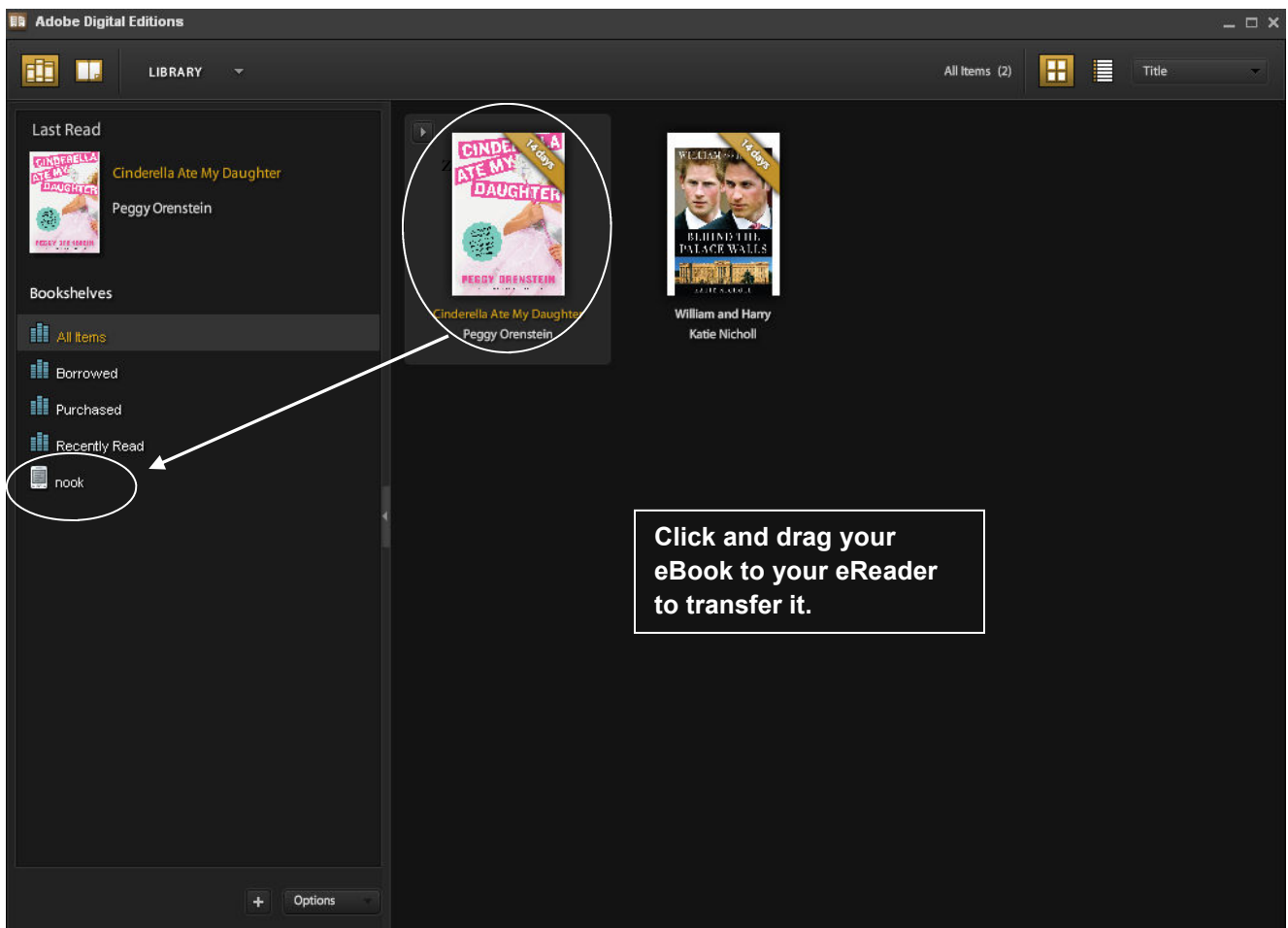
Users of these devices will need to download and install a free copy of the Adobe Digital Editions program. The program should be installed to your computer, not your eReader device. After installing the program, you will need to create and sign in with a free Adobe ID. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete these steps.

How to Transfer eBooks to an eReader

Open Adobe Digital Editions and plug your compatible eReader device in to your computer. Visit www.mediaondemand.org for a complete list of compatible devices.

You should see all of your downloaded books in the program's 'Library View'. Additionally, your eReader should now be listed under the 'Bookshelves' section.

To transfer a book to your device simply click on the book's cover and drag it to your eReader's listing under 'Bookshelves' - just like moving a file.



Automatic Expiration

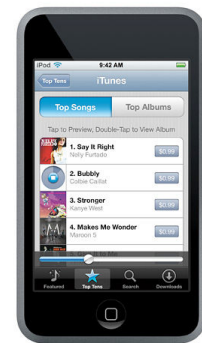
At the end of the lending period, each title will automatically expire and be returned. There are no late fees! The file will still be visible on your computer and device, but will be unable to be opened. Delete the expired files using Adobe Digital Editions.

Checking In Books

You have the option to return your eBook before its due date if you finish reading it early. To return a book early, use the library view within Adobe Digital Editions to select the title to be returned. Click on the white arrow to the upper left of the image of each book's cover to open the book's menu. Select "Return Borrowed Item" from the menu that appears. This will return the digital title to Media on Demand and allow you to check a new item out. *Kindle users can return books by accessing your Kindle account on Amazon.com.*

Mobile Devices

Are you using an iPod Touch, iPad, Android, or other "smart" device? You can now download ebooks directly to your compatible mobile device. Download the free OverDrive Media Console app to browse, check out, and download- without needing a computer! Visit www.mediaondemand.org for details and system requirements.
