- E/BANG           **When Sophie Gets Angry – Really, Really Angry**  
A young girl is upset and doesn't know how to manage her anger but takes the time to cool off and regain her composure.
- E/BEAUMONT      **Move Over, Rover**  
When a storm comes, Rover expects to have his safe and dry doghouse all to himself but he soon finds that various other animals, including a skunk, also want a cozy place to sit out the rain.
- E/BEAMONT       **I Ain't Gonna Paint No More!**  
Excited with the art he has created on the walls, a young artist decides to continue on with his vibrant creations--soon painting the floors, ceiling, and himself in the process!
- E/BIEDRZYCKI    **Me and My Dragon**  
A child tells all the reasons a small, fire-breathing dragon would make an excellent pet, and the ways to take proper care of it.
- E/BRUNHOFF      **Babar's ABC**  
The residents of Celesteville present the letters of the alphabet, accompanied by words and sentences for each letter.
- E/BRUNHOFF      **Babar's Counting Book**  
Babar's children, Flora, Pom, and Alexander, go for a walk and count all of the interesting things they see, pleasing their father so much that he teaches them to count all the way to twenty.
- E/BUEHNER       **Snowmen At Night**  
After nighttime falls and everyone is asleep in their beds, a group of fun-loving snowmen jump into action and have their own bit of fun while no one is around to see.
- E/BUNTING       **Hurry, Hurry**  
All the animals of the barnyard community hurry to greet their newest member, who is just pecking his way out of an egg.
- E/BURTON         **Mike Mulligan and His Steam Shovel**  
When Mike Mulligan and his steam shovel, Mary Ann, lose their jobs to the gasoline, electric, and diesel motor shovels, they go to a little country town where they find that one new job leads to another.

- E/DEEDY           **The Library Dragon**  
Miss Lotta Scales is a dragon who believes her job is to protect the school's library books from the children, but when she finally realizes that books are meant to be read, the dragon turns into Miss Lotty, librarian and storyteller.
- E/DUNREA           **Merry Christmas, Ollie!**  
On Christmas Eve, Ollie and the other goslings anxiously await the arrival of Father Christmas Goose.
- E/EHLERT           **Leaf Man**  
A man made of leaves blows away, traveling wherever the wind may take him.
- E/FRENCH           **Diary of a Baby Wombat**  
Through a week of diary entries, a wombat describes his life of sleeping, playing, and helping his mother look for a bigger hole in which to make their home.
- E/FROMENTAL       **365 Penguins**  
When a box containing a penguin arrives anonymously on New Year's Day, a family of four is puzzled, but as they continue to receive one penguin each day their problems--and food budget, and storage issues--are multiplied.
- E/HOBBIE           **Toot and Puddle: Top of the World**  
When Toot, a pig who loves to travel, takes a walk that turns into a trip to France and Nepal, his friend Puddle sets out to find him.
- E/HUBBELL           **Trucks: Whizz! Zoom! Rumble!**  
A rhyming look at many different kinds of trucks, from eighteen-wheelers to ice cream trucks, as they go about their business.
- E/JENKINS           **Actual Size**  
Discusses and gives examples of the size and weight of various animals and parts of animals.
- E/JENKINS           **Prehistoric Actual Size**  
Through informative descriptions and bold illustrations, including two detailed gatefolds, young readers are introduced to dinosaurs of various giant sizes through an examination of how they moved, the way they hunted, and the types of food they ate.
- E/JENKINS           **What Do You Do With a Tail Like This?**  
Simple text presents the many things animals can do with their ears, eyes, mouths, noses, feet, and tails.

- E/JOHNSON      **Snow Sounds**  
In a nearly-wordless book, a young boy, eager to reach a much-anticipated holiday party on time, listens to the sounds of the shovels, snow plow, and other equipment used to clear his way.
- E/KARAS      **On Earth**  
We are all passengers of the Earth as it spins, tilts and circles the sun. Learn about Earth's cycles of rotation and revolution, plus how they affect our lives through the days and seasons.
- E/KASZA      **The Dog Who Cried Wolf**  
Tired of being a house pet, Moka the dog moves to the mountains to become a wolf but soon misses the comforts of home.
- E/LICHTENHELD      **What Are You So Grumpy About?**  
A collection of cartoons that present various reasons for being grumpy, such as eating "grown-up" cereal, getting a boring birthday present, doing chores, and being touched by your brother or sister.
- E/MARKLE      **A Mother's Journey**  
An acclaimed nonfiction author presents the daring story of a mother emperor penguin's struggle to reach the sea, find food, avoid predators, and make her way back to her mate and their newborn chick before they starve.
- E/MAYER      **There's A Nightmare in My Closet**  
At bedtime a boy confronts the nightmare in his closet and finds him not so terrifying after all.
- E/MEDDAUGH      **Martha Speaks**  
Problems arise when Martha, the family dog, learns to speak after eating alphabet soup.
- E/NEWGARDEN      **Bow-Wow Bugs a Bug**  
A wordless picture book about a persistent terrier that spends a day following a bug through his neighborhood.
- E/PEARSON      **Slugs in Love**  
Marylou and Herbie, two garden slugs, write love poems in slime to one another but have trouble actually meeting.
- E/PFISTER      **The Rainbow Fish**  
The most beautiful fish in the entire ocean discovers the real value of personal beauty and friendship.

- E/PIPER                    **The Little Engine That Could**  
When a little train is unable to pull her heavy load over the mountain she asks the little blue engine for help.
- E/RATHMANN            **Good Night, Gorilla**  
A zookeeper finds his normal nighttime routine upset when a mischievous little ape steals his keys and lets all his animal charges out of their cages.
- E/RYAN                    **Hello Ocean**  
Using rhyming text, a child describes the wonder of the ocean experienced through each of her five senses.
- E/SHANNON            **The Rain Came Down**  
An unexpected rain shower causes quarreling among the members of a small community.
- E/STEAD                   **A Sick Day For Amos McGee**  
Amos McGee, a friendly zoo keeper, always makes time to visit his animal friends, but when he becomes sick and cannot come in to work, the animals pay him a visit instead.
- E/TEAGUE                **Dear Mrs. La Rue**  
Gertrude LaRue receives typewritten and paw-written letters from her dog Ike, entreating her to let him leave the Igor Brotweiler Canine Academy and come back home.
- E/TEAGUE                **Detective LaRue**  
While on vacation, Mrs. LaRue receives letters from her dog Ike who has been falsely accused of harming the neighbor's cats and is trying to clear his name.
- E/THOMAS                **What Will Fat Cat Sit On?**  
A group of animals is terrified at the prospect of being sat upon by the imposing Fat Cat, until the mouse comes up with a solution that satisfies everyone.
- E/TRAPANI                **The Itsy Bitsy Spider**  
The itsy-bitsy spider encounters a fan, a mouse, a cat, and a rocking chair as she makes her way to the top of a tree to spin her web.
- E/WHEELER              **Bubble Gum, Bubble Gum**  
After a variety of animals get stuck one by one in bubble gum melting in the road, they must survive encounters with a big blue truck and a burly black bear.

While Piglet waits for his fun-loving Granny to visit, he impresses the other farm animals with some of the skills she has taught him, such as balancing and turning somersaults.
