


How To Use Our Green Screen App


- 1) Turn on iPad by holding top right button down
- 2) Once on, find and click on the Green Screen App to open it.
(We use Green Screen by Do Ink)



- 3) Click on the + in the top right corner and choose "Create New Project".




- 4) Near the bottom of the screen there should be an area next to "Save" that says "Video" and "Image". Make sure that "Image" is chosen in blue.




For a photo that is just going to have a background....


- 5) Click on the first + on the right side of the screen and choose camera.




- 6) Once clicked you should have a camera view on your screen and the line next to the first + should be a yellow stripe with cameras.




***Note: If the iPad camera is showing you and not what you're looking at hit the little camera shape on the top white bar to change the view.




7) Click on the second + and choose "Image".




8) From the albums menu that pops up choose "Green Screen".



9) Click on which ever photo you want as your background.



It should show up in a mini box. If you are sure you want that photo hit “Use” in the top right hand corner. If you don’t want that photo you can hit “<Green Screen” and it will take you back to all the photos.




*** Note: when you are back on the main screen you can change your background whenever you like by hitting the second + again and following the above steps to add a photo.


10) Now that you have a background hold the Ipad up and line the screen up with your green screen. Have someone pose in front of it.



11) When ready, take their photo by hitting the circle button next to image.



12) Your photo should show up on your screen. At the bottom of the screen on the white bar click on “Done”. A message will pop up asking you if you want to discard or save your image. If you want to keep the photo click on “Save to the Camera Roll”. You should receive a message saying “Success!”. From there click on “OK”. Then click “Done” in the bottom right hand corner to go back to the program. If you don’t like your photo click on “Discard This Image”. It will automatically clear the photo and take you back to the main screen. We cannot retrieve the photo once it’s been discarded.




*** Note: Any photos that are “Saved” will be added to an online link the Teens can access from home. They should take a slip of paper with the site home with them so they don’t forget.


For a photo that is just going to have an overlay....

After you create a new project (up to step 4).....

- 1) Click on the first blue + and choose “Image” from the source list to bring up the albums. From the album list choose “Green Screen Overlay”. This is the picture that will go in the very front of everything.




Choose your overlay just like you would a photo from the “just a background” instructions.



Once you've chosen your overlay and you bring it on to your screen, you can use your fingers to shrink, enlarge, or move the image.

The second + will this time be your camera and the third plus will be your background. See "For a photo that is just going to have a background...." For more in depth instructions on how to do those steps.

Your 3 + should look something like the photo below when you're ready to take a photo.



Follow steps 10-13 in "For a photo that is just going to have a background...." To see how to take and save your photos.

Overlay photos can turn out like the one below....



Have the Teens use chairs, benches, props, and even themselves covered with a green table cloth to create awesome effects....




How To Use Our Updated Green Screen App

- 1) Turn on iPad by holding top right button down


- 3) Click on the + in the top right corner and choose "Create New Project".




- 4) At the top of the next screen there should be an area next to "Capture the Image" that says "Video" and "Image". Make sure that "Image" is chosen in blue.

For a photo that is just going to have a background....


- 1) Click on the first + on the right side of the screen and choose add camera.
- 2) Once clicked you should have a camera view on your screen and the line next to the first + should be a yellow stripe with cameras.




***Note: If the iPad camera is showing you and not what you're looking at hit the little camera shape on the top white bar to change the view.



- 3) Click on the second + and choose "Albums".
- 4) From the albums menu that pops up choose "Green Screen".



5) Click on which ever photo you want as your background.




It should show up in the box on the left. Re-size it using by touching the image so that it fits in your photo view box. If you don't want that photo you can choose another photo from the right and it will change it out. Hit "Done" on the upper right side of the photo choices when you have found the right photo. This will make the green screen edit area larger.

*** Note: when you are back on the main screen you can change your background whenever you like by hitting the second + again and following the above steps to add a photo.

6) Now that you have a background hold the Ipad up and line the screen up with your green screen. Have someone pose in front of it.



- 7) When ready, take their photo by hitting the “capture image” button highlighted in green at the top of the screen.
- 8) Your photo should show up on your screen. At the bottom of the screen on the white bar click on “Done”. A message will pop up asking you if you want to discard or save your image. If you want to keep the photo click on “Save to the Camera Roll”. You should receive a message saying “Success!”. From there click on “OK”. Then click “Done” in the bottom right hand corner to go back to the program. If you don’t like your photo click on “Discard This Image”. It will automatically clear the photo and take you back to the main screen. We cannot retrieve the photo once it’s been discarded.
