

TAKE & MAKE

CRAFT KIT

YARN WRAPPED VALENTINE

Supplies:

- Cardstock Heart
- Red paper in the shape of a heart (2)
- Yarn (two shades)
- Scissors
- A glue stick

1 Gather your materials!

2 Apply glue all over one side of your cardboard heart and line one of the red hearts up with its edges, sticking it into place so it matches the cardboard all the way around and covers it.

Flip the whole heart shape over and repeat the covering process, applying glue all over the remaining cardboard side and sticking the matching red shape down on that side as well.





Apply glue to the end of the first color of yarn you want to wrap with and stick it down on whichever side of your heart you want to be the back. Pass the ball through the hole in the center of your heart



Keep wrapping but, as you go, move the yarn around in different angles and at different lengths and distances as you move along the red edge to cut a cute, eclectic, and purposely uneven effect. Make your way all the way around the whole heart until you meet back up with the other end or simply decide you've had enough of that color. Cut the yarn free, apply glue to that end, and stick it down on the same back side as you started on before.



Repeat and continue this wrapping process with your other yarn colors until you're satisfied. You can do them by turn or keep them attached and alternate them; do whatever makes you feel satisfied with the look! When you're done with each color,

cut the ends free and glue them down in the same way you did with the first color.
