Volunteer Background Check Permission Form**

The Orland Park Public Library's Volunteer Application states the library will conduct background checks on all of its volunteers. On January 1, 1991, the Uniform Conviction Information Act (UCIA) became law in Illinois. The act mandates that all criminal history record conviction information collected and maintained by the Illinois State Police (ISP), Bureau of Identification (BOI), be made available to the public pursuant to 20 ILCS 2635/1 et seq. This law permits only conviction information to be disseminated to the public.
