MAKE

CLOTHESPIN NAPKIN HOLDER

Materials:
Clothespins
Glue

Directions:

1. Twist each clothespin to separate it into two halves. Remove and discard the metal wire.
2. Flip the separated clothespins so they are flat side to flat side, and glue together 28 sets. You should have individual pieces left over.
3. Glue the sets together on the flat sides. You should have 13 glued together in a half-circle shape.
4. On the end of each side of the half-circle, attach one single piece of a clothespin so the flat side is facing the outside.
5. Repeat steps 3 & 4 with the other clothespin sets so that you have two half circles.
6. To join the two halves, take 4 single clothespin pieces and glue two single pieces side by side. Repeat with the additional two.
7. To make the flat base, glue the sets from step 6 onto the bottom edge of one of the half-circles of your napkin holder.
8. Glue the two halves of the napkin holder together via the flat base. Allow to dry.
