


Reusable Sandwich Wrap



Need:

Cotton Square (Included)
Scissors
Iron
Bees Wax (Included)
Parchment Paper
Ruler
Velcro (Included)
Needle and Thread (Included)

Instructions:

- 1) Take a large piece of parchment paper (or two) and lay them flat on a table. Lay your cotton square on top of the paper making sure that there is parchment under all of the square. Lightly sprinkle the bees wax beads on top of your cotton square. The wax will melt and spread, so you don't need a lot. Lay parchment paper over your square and wax. Iron on top of the parchment paper to melt your wax. Be sure to press down and move the iron around so that the melted wax spreads out. If you take your parchment paper off and the wax doesn't look fully melted, put the parchment paper back on and re-melt the area. Do this as many times as needed. Your cloth should still easily bend and fold when done.
- 2) Once you have your cloth lightly covered in wax, remove all the parchment paper. Measure a 13 inch by 13 inch square on your cotton square, and cut it out.
- 3) The Velcro can be tricky. You have two matching sets in your kit. Each set is going to have to go kiddie corner across from each other, but also on opposite sides of the cloth. Picture three demonstrates this. Yellow goes with yellow. Red with red. Test the placement by just using the sticky side of the Velcro first. Once you have it placed how you want it, use a simple stich to sew the Velcro in place.
- 4) The photos below show how to wrap a sandwich. Take one corner and fold it over. Take the opposite corner and connect the Velcro. Do the same thing to the other two corners. Ta Da! Your sandwich is wrapped.
- 5) Your wrap can be rinsed off anytime with water and gentle soap.















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
