

DIY Floral Soap

Supplies:

Square mold
Dried herbs
Soap glycerin
Microwave safe bowl (Not Provided)
Food coloring (Optional, Not Provided)



Instructions:

Step one: Put your chunks of soap glycerin in your microwave safe bowl. Heat on high for 30 seconds at a time, stirring in between until it is completely melted.

Step two: If you would like to use food coloring, mix it in once your soap glycerin has melted completely.

Step three: Sprinkle as much of the loose herbs in as you would like to use into your empty mold. The more you use, the more fragrant your soap will be.

Step four: Once your glycerin has cooled enough that it has begun to solidify around the edges, pour it carefully into your mold. If you would like, you can stop and layer your tea leaves in the mold until you've filled it.

Step five: Leave your soap to set for at least six hours, and ideally overnight.

Step six: Carefully peel your mold off your newly set soap.

Step seven: Keep it for yourself, or wrap it up nicely as a gift for a loved one.
