

TAKE — and — MAKE

WOOL DRYER BALLS

Materials:

- 100% Wool Yarn
- 1 Piece of Pantyhose

Directions:

1. Create a yarn ball: Begin by wrapping the yarn around 2 fingers about 15-20 times. Then, slip the yarn off your fingers and wrap the yarn around the middle – it should kind of look like a bow. Continue wrapping the yarn tightly several times in one direction and then wrap the yarn several times in another direction. Repeat until you run out of yarn.
2. Tuck the end of the yarn under the strands of yarn to secure it.
3. Put the yarn ball into the pantyhose and then tie a tight knot in the pantyhose to secure the ball inside.
4. Put pantyhose with yarn ball inside into the washing machine. Run a very hot wash cycle. They can be washed alone or with other laundry that can withstand a hot wash cycle.
5. After washing, place the pantyhose with the yarn ball inside into the dryer. Run a very high heat dryer cycle.
6. After the yarn ball is completely dry, remove it from the pantyhose. The dryer ball is now ready to use!

Optional:

You may add a few drops of an essential oil to the dryer ball if you wish to infuse a scent.
