

Wisteria Room Decor



Supplies:

- Light Purple Cardstock
- Purple Cardstock
- Green Cardstock
- Dark Green Cardstock
- Green Paracord
- Thread
- Needle (not provided)
- Glue Gun (not provided)
- Scissors (not provided)
- Pencil (not provided)

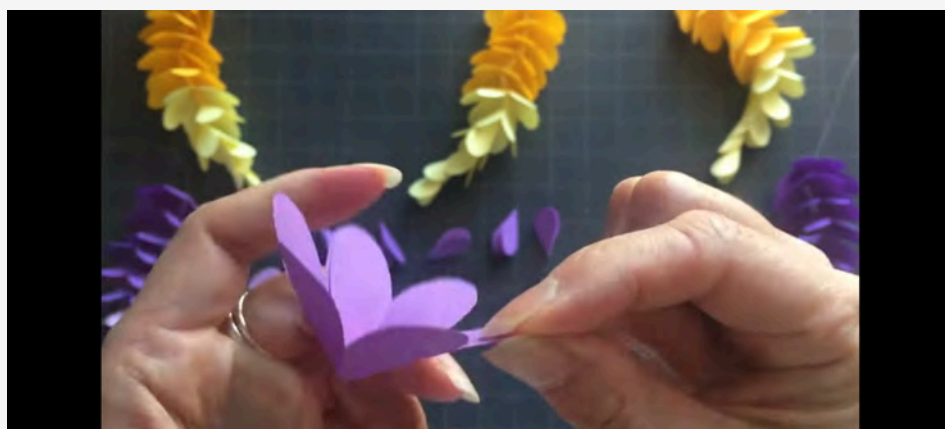
Instructions:

Start by cutting out all the flowers and the leaves.

For the **Dark Purple** flowers:



Cut off **one** petal out of all of them. Then glue the **two** petals next to the one you cut off on top of each other. Do this to **all** of the dark purple flowers. You should end up with 6 petals on each flower.



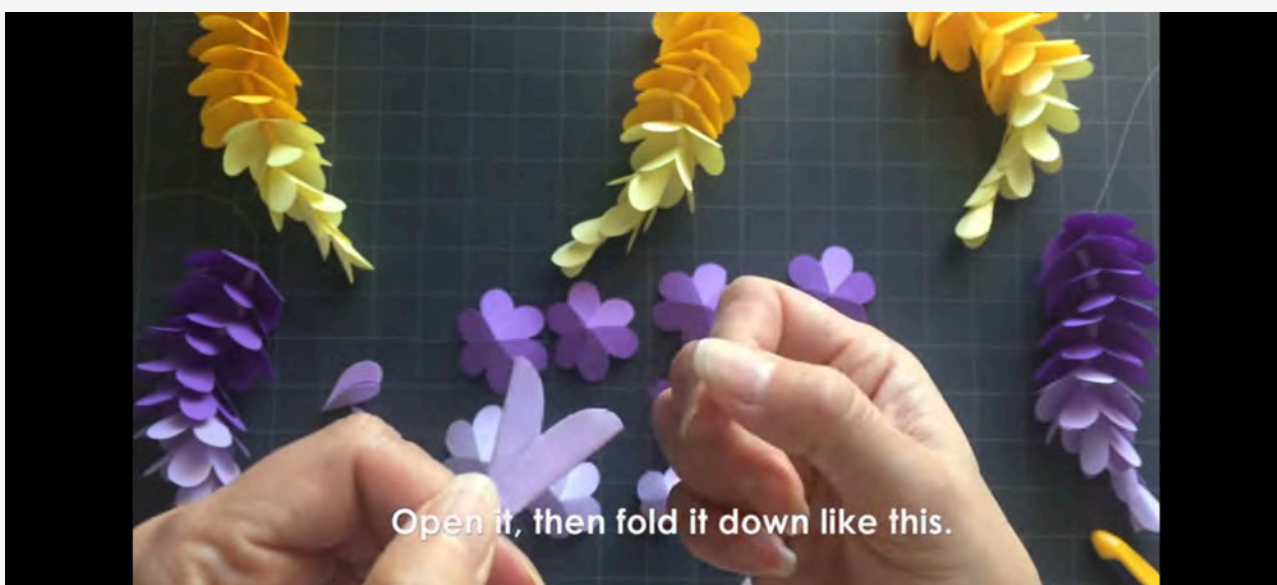
For the **Light Purple** flowers:

You cut off **two** petals off of **3** **light purple** flowers and glue the two petals next to the one you cut off on top of each other. You should end up with **5** petals on each of these flowers.

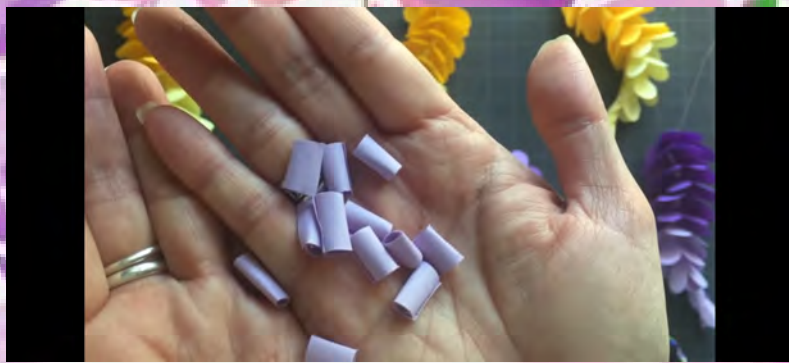


For the next set of **3** **light purple** flowers you will cut off **three** petals and then glue the petals next to the ones you cut off on top of each other. You should end up with **4** petals on each of these flowers.

For your last set of **3** **light purple** flowers you will cut off four petals and glue the petal next to it on top of each other. You should end up with **3** petals on each of these flowers.



You will have **3** sets of **3** petals remaining from your leftover clippings. You will glue these together to form **2** petals on each of these flowers.



You will have 2 strips of paper that you will need to roll around a pencil to form a tube. you will glue the on of the paper so it keeps its shape. Cut into equal 1/4" pieces or desired length, these pieces will help space your flowers out.

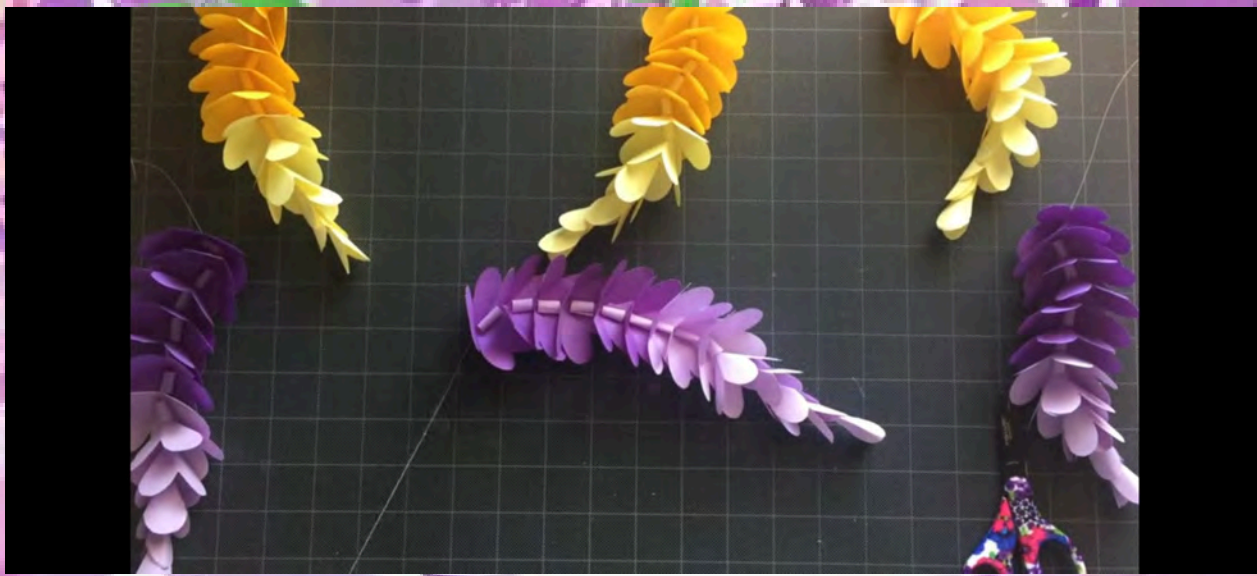
To Assemble:



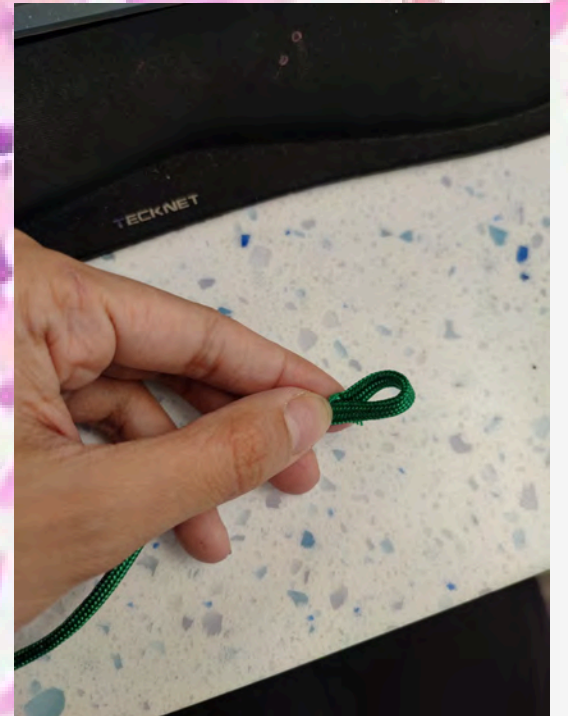
In order to put it together you will need a needle. Thread the provided thread on the needle and you will begin with the smallest flower and work your way towards the biggest flower. Tie a knot at the end of the string and add a dot of glue to it to keep it in place.



Once dry, simply push the needle through the center of the flower and then ad a piece of the paper tube before you place another flower. You will make 3 strands of wisteria flowers so make sure to distribute your flowers evenly so you have an even amount in each strand.



Once you're done making the flower strands tie them on the paracord provided and add a dot of glue to keep them in place. Then glue your leaves to your liking on the paracord to hide the strings. For the ends of the paracord you can loop the, to the back of it and add glue to keep them in place like so.
