

## Tea Light Snowman



<u>Supplies:</u> Tea Light Ribbon Permanent Marker Pom Pom Balls Scissors Glue (Hot Glue Works Best)



## Instructions:

Use a black Sharpie to draw a simple face onto the tea light.

Cut a piece of ribbon approximately 2.5" long. Glue it around the top of the tea light. This will be part of the ear muffs.

Take another small piece of ribbon and glue the 2 ends to the middle of the other ribbon to create a loop. This you can use to hang your snowman up.

Add a generous dab of hot glue where the ears would be and add the pom poms, one on each side. Now your snowman has ear muffs!

Cut out a piece of ribbon to be approximately 4.5" long. Then cross it over itself and add a small dab of hot glue to hold it together. This is the snowman's scarf. Glue it to the bottom of the tea light so it hangs down like a scarf.

The tea light flame is white when it's turned off so you'll probably want to color it orange with a marker to make it look like a carrot, even when the tea light is turned off.

If you'd like to make another snowman, try using felt to make a top hat for him.
